CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (THIS FORM MUST BE SIGNED)

1. Exhibitors must comply with directions of the club officers and section stewards.
2. Abusive behaviour- whether verbal, physical, or written – will not be tolerated on site under any circumstances. Any violation will result in immediate removal from the premises and the event.
3. Exhibitors must ensure all drivers are fully competent & qualified by law to handle the class of vehicle exhibited. Failing to produce relevant documents which apply to your vehicle, will result in you being asked to leave the site. **You must comply the Road Traffic Act - A maximum speed of 5 mph shall always apply to all moving vehicles on rally site.**
4. Exhibitors must hold the correct insurance of the exhibit, and they must have adequate Public Liability Insurance cover for **no less than £5,000,000 (5 million Pounds GBP)** (cover for moving around rally site and Static too)
5. Exhibits must be presented in a clean, complete & safe working condition and No exhibit may be left running unattended & must be left securely braked & immobilised. – *we may check this*
6. No tractor or vehicle shall carry, at any time, more persons than for which it was originally designed and constructed by the manufacturer.
7. **Exhibits are expected to be shown between the hours of 9am and 4:30pm on both days. There is no unauthorised vehicle movement within this time.**
8. Vehicle Exhibits are expected to take part in the Ring Parade on both days. (Weather permitting)
9. **Awnings / Gazebos are not permitted in any of the camping areas.**
10. **Open Fires are not permitted in accordance with landowners' conditions.**
11. Exhibitors are reminded that vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas, or they will be asked to move.
12. **Dogs must be kept on a lead. Owners are required to clean up after their dogs.**
13. Exhibitors are reminded that entry to the site will not be permitted before 10am on Thursday 11th June 2026, 9am on Friday 12th and must leave the site by 12 noon on Monday 15th June 2026.
14. No additional vehicles may be brought onto the site without prior permission from your section steward.
15. All Exhibitors and Exhibits, items for sale or articles remain on site are at the sole risk of the Exhibitor/ Trader/ Caterer, the organisers will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to equipment or persons whilst on the site.

Safety Policy. The chairperson and committee place utmost importance on safety, requiring all members, visitors, exhibitors and contractors to follow this policy and take reasonable steps to prevent injury. Any health and safety concerns must be addressed immediately and report to the Safety Officer, a committee Member, or a responsible person. Due to health and safety regulations, exhibit numbers may be limited: therefore, priority is given to club members, on two-day entries received by closing date, though acceptance is not guaranteed, everyone's health and safety remain our top priority. I agree to the above conditions of entry for my application to be considered and the use of my data for Club purposes only.
