CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (THIS FORM MUST BE SIGNED)

1. Exhibitors must comply with directions of the club officers and section stewards.
2. Exhibitors must ensure all drivers are fully competent & qualified by law to handle the class of vehicle exhibited. You may be asked to produce relevant documents which apply to your vehicle. Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the site. **You must comply to the road Traffic Act.**
3. **Exhibitors must hold the correct insurance of the exhibit and they must have adequate Public Liability Insurance cover for no less than £5,000,000 (cover for moving around rally site and Static too)**
4. **Awnings / Gazebos are NOT PERMITTED in any of the camping areas or in the Stationary Engine Line.**
5. Exhibits must be presented in a clean, complete & safe working condition and No exhibit may be left running unattended & must be left securely braked & immobilised.
6. **Steam powered exhibits must send a copy of current Boiler Certificate with this form and bring the original valid certificate to the rally for inspection.**
7. Steam Exhibits are expected to take part in the Ring Parade on both days. (Weather permitting)
8. **Steam Exhibits are NOT to drive through the trading or camping areas.**
9. **A maximum speed of 5 mph shall apply to all moving vehicles on rally site.**
10. **Engines and other exhibits are expected to be shown working between the hours of 9am and 4:30pm on both days. There is no site movement within this time.**
11. Exhibitors are reminded that vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas, or they will be asked to leave the site.
12. **All dogs must be always kept on a leads. Please clean up after your dogs.**
13. Exhibitors are reminded that entry to the site will not be permitted before 10am on Thursday 12th June 2025 9am Friday the 13th June and must leave the site by 12 noon on Monday 16th June 2025
14. Exhibitors aged 16 years and under must be always supervised by an adult.
15. **Open Fires are not permitted in accordance with landowners' conditions.**
16. Exhibitors will be provided with wristbands on arrival of rally site, please ensure these are worn at all times/ visible.
17. No additional vehicles may be brought onto the site without prior permission from your section steward.
18. All Exhibitors and Exhibits, items for sale or articles remain on site are at the sole risk of the Exhibitor/ Trader/ Caterer, the organisers will not be responsible for any loss damage or injury to equipment or persons whilst on the site.
19. **Safety Policy.** The Chairman and the members of the committee regard safety as paramount importance in all activities. It is intended and the duty of all members, visitors, exhibitors and contractors to comply with the objectives of this Safety Policy and to do all that is reasonably practicable to prevent injury to themselves or others.
